

# Great Falls fine home enjoys the fine views

The six-year-old white stucco-and-fieldstone custom home at 202 Carrwood Road in Great Falls is designed to take full advantage of the views of its wooded five-acre lot. It also provides the convenience of six bedrooms, six full baths and two powder rooms in its 9,650 square feet.

It is listed at \$3,500,000 with Dan Laytham and Jan Kendall of Long & Foster. Call 703-759-9190.

The note of natural elegance is sounded in the fieldstone front entry with its flagstone porch and steps; the two-level flagstone rear patio and the flagstone decking for the in-ground heated gunite pool. Flagstone floors and a vaulted ceiling also appear in the screened porch off the kitchen/breakfast room.

In the two-story foyer, a curved hardwood staircase stands within a two-story window wall and provides impressive views through the great room of the back yard and woods beyond.

The two-story, step-down great room features dramatic window walls overlooking the patio, pool and backyard and glass doors leading to the deck. It also provides a two-sided wood-burning fireplace with one of the raised limestone

hearths that are found throughout the house, providing aesthetic unity while echoing the natural theme.

An angular wall of five windows and a door leading to the screened porch help the breakfast room share the spirit. The adjoining kitchen features custom maple cabinets, granite counters and status stainless-steel appliances like a Sub Zero refrigerator/freezer, two Dacor convection wall ovens, a KitchenAid microwave and dual Miele dishwashers. Between the kitchen and the dining room, the butler's pantry includes maple cabinets, an undercounter refrigerator, stainless-steel counters and glass cabinets.

The dining room and living room feature two-sided fireplaces with limestone surrounds. A two-story vaulted ceiling adds drama to the living room, while the dining room boasts a five-paneled bow window.

European maple-paneled walls and cabinets, adjustable bookcases and shelves and a two-sided woodburning fireplace with a limestone surround add distinction to the library. It is brightened by picture windows and casement windows.

Windows also frame the bed in the main-floor guest suite, which includes three closets. French doors open onto the

private balcony overlooking the pool and backyard. The private bath boasts a marble floor, vanity and shower with a seat, dual heads and spray plus a whirlpool tub.

In addition to the dramatic main stairway, a rear staircase leads to the upper and lower levels.

With such a splendid guest suite, a visitor would naturally expect the master suite to be truly spectacular and would not be disappointed. Beyond double doors, it displays hardwood floors with a tray ceiling, a gas fireplace with a limestone surround and hearth and a six-paned bow window overlooking the pool and back yard. The sumptuous marble-tiled bath provides dual concealed commodes, a glass shower with two doors and eight nozzles and a Jacuzzi whirlpool tub beneath two skylights and a half-circle window, in addition to dual closets with

dressing areas.

Another bedroom has a bow window plus a private bath. The other two bedrooms share a "buddy bath" between them.

Another bedroom suite is found in the lower level. This level also includes an office with a built-in desk, shelves and counters; a mirrored exercise room with French doors leading to the pool and patio; and a walk-in wine cellar with room for more than 1,000 bottles. Adjoining the wine cellar, the billiard room is also open to the recreation/media room, providing a unified entertainment area. The recreation room boasts an eight-foot Stewart projection screen, a Runco projector, multiple B&W speakers and double French doors leading to the pool, patio and back yard.
